what word do I choose? / one that will answer the what-who-where are you from / I'm not half or multi- / but aren't I a combination of many? / a combination not often encountered / a bone people want to chew / eager to categorize / have to pick one or the other / I stitch my own identity / tapping into my ancestors / my blood guides me / running hot & cold / mixed / not mixed-up / I know who I am / I am rootxpansive / my roots expanding from South Asia to Eastern Europe to North America / my roots - not torn - not fractured - only growing longer & strong / stretching across cultures / adapting & thriving / rootxpansive / a knowing of who I am no one can take away
